

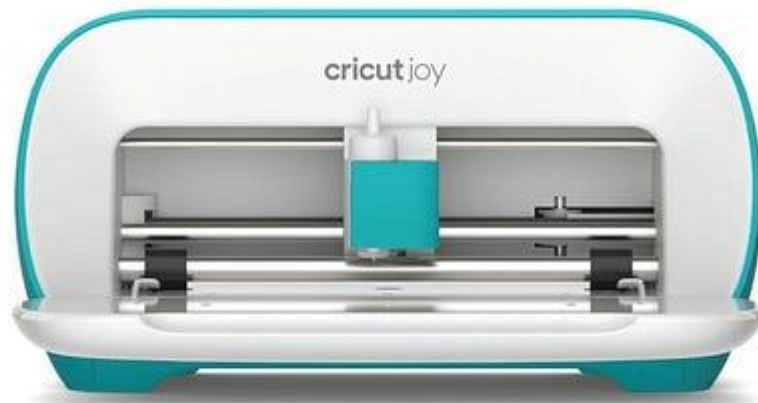
# 3 Best Cricut for Beginners: Top Picks for Easy Crafting
